- I. Call to Order. The meeting was called to order at 10:09 a.m..
- II. Minutes (November 10, 2020). March and July minutes were approved by common consent.
- III. Reports
 - a. City of Rome. – Messer reported for the City. He reported the city submitted their LMIG application in February. The application is for approx.. \$400,00 which will pave about 4 miles. He also stated the Mt. Berry trail is temporarily closed for construction.
 - b. Floyd County. – Almost all of the 2020 LMIG projects are complete. The county submitted the 2021 LMIG application. This application is for approx. \$450,000. He also reported Booger Hollow Road should be done by the end of the year. And Shady Lane SPLOST project is almost complete.
 - c. City of Cave Spring. – No report.
 - d. Metropolitan Planning Organization.
 - i. 2021-2024 TIP Projects – Schaaf presented the updated TIP projects to the committee. No one had any comments or concerns.
 - ii. Performance Measure Adoption – The MPO is required to adopt or create their own safety target annually. The MPO chose to adopt the existing targets. Ivey made a motion to recommend to adopt the measures. Ciavarro seconded the motion. The 2021 safety targets will now go before TPC for adoption.
 - e. Rome Transit Department. – No report.
 - f. Georgia Department of Transportation.
 - i. District 6 Engineering Office – Caivarro reported for GDOT. He reported SR 1 Loop to 20 is set to start this Monday (1/18). SR 140 is scheduled to be complete October 22. He also stated there will be a possible improvement

study completed at SR1 and E 12th Street. Findings will be presented at a later date.
