- I. Call to Order. The meeting was called to order at 10:09 a.m..

- III. Reports
  - a. City of Rome. – Jenkins reported for the City. He reported the City has started 2021 LMIG projects. This includes about 15 miles of paving, sidewalk, pavements, and road improvements
  - a. Floyd County. – Skeen reported for the County. He reported the county completed 26% of 2021 paving list so far – about 21 miles are scheduled. The county recently received a \$200,000 grant from the GDOT for safety. Bid package is out now for thermo-stripping and new signs for 30 miles of County Roads. Booger Hollow bridge is still closed, but the change order has been completed and the contractor is back at work soon. Floyd County was recently awarded a grant to fund the replacement of a bridge on Rehoboth Road – scheduled for GDOT 2023. Shady Lane has been paved, along with Calliers Springs Road back to 411. Construction crews are back at work on sidewalks, rotating back and forth between Riverside and Lindale
  - b. City of Cave Spring. – No report.
  - c. Metropolitan Planning Organization.
    - i. TAP Application - Schaaf reported for the MPO. She presented the TAP application that will be turned in at the end of the month.

- d. Rome Transit Department. – Shealy reported for RTD. She reported RTD is waiting to hear back from FTA about tripper bus liquidation. After this, RTD can proceed with the implementation process.
  - e. Georgia Department of Transportation – Caivarro, District 6 Engineering, reported for GDOT. He gave updates on current and upcoming projects in the County.
