



Notice of Property Tax Increase

The Rome City Commission announces its intention to hold a Public Hearing at the City Commission meeting on Monday, July 12th, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall, 601 Broad Street concerning the proposed 2021 millage tax rate. The proposed combined rates for the City government and City Schools of 27.427 will result in no increase of millage rate from prior year but will be an increase of 5.6% (1.453) over the calculated rollback rate for City M&O and School tax. The City is proposing to adopt a roll back rate on Capital from 1.935 to 1.826 which will result in no increase to Capital tax. For a non-homestead property, the estimated City and City School tax for a current \$125,000 market valued home would have been \$1,377 in 2020. At the proposed rate for 2021, the estimated tax will be \$1,371 and at the 2021 roll back rate, the estimated tax would be \$1,299. For non-homestead property with fair market value of \$100,000 the proposed 2021 rate of 27.427 would be \$1,097 compared to the rollback rate of 25.974 and \$1,039, a 5.6% increase. All concerned citizens are invited to this public hearing. Additional Public Hearings will be held on Thursday, July 15th at 10 a.m. and Monday, July 26th at 6:30 p.m.
